What will I be studying?

The aims of these qualifications are to develop learner understanding and skills in

- Representing selecting the mathematics and information to model a situation
- Analysing processing and using mathematics
- Interpreting interpreting and communication the results of the analysis

What skills will I develop?

- Understand practical problems in familiar and unfamiliar contexts and situations, some of which are non-routine
- Identify and obtain necessary information to tackle a mathematical problem
- Select mathematics in an organised way to find solutions
- Apply mathematics in an organised way to find solutions to straightforward practical problems for different purposes
- Interpret and communicate solutions to practical problems, drawing simple conclusions and giving explanations

How will the course be structured?

You will be assessed through one exam at the end of the course lasting 1 hour 30 minutes

What are the aims of Additional Maths?

- Accelerate the progress of students in Maths so that they have a better chance of achieving a 4 at GCSE
- Support students' learning and motivation in relation to mathematics
- Help students meet the high demands of other GCSE courses that need high levels of numeracy
- Strengthen the key area of numeracy sought by employer
