The new course covers three distinct themes	100% Examination at the end of the two year course (all four skills are 25% each)
These themes apply to all four question papers. Students are expected to understand and provide information and opinions about these themes relating to their own experiences and those of other people, including people in countries/communities where the language is spoken. <b>Theme 1</b> Identity and culture <b>Theme 2</b> Local, national, international and global areas of interest <b>Theme 3</b> Current and future study and employment	There are two tiers of entry: Foundation and Higher Tier Listening & Reading: Understanding and responding to different types of spoken and written language Speaking & Writing: Communicating and interacting effectively in speech and writing for a variety of purposes Students will continue to be assessed every half term in all 4 skills throughout the course. Students will also have Mid-Year & End of Year exams in Year 10 as well as the GCSE Mock exam at the end of the Autumn term in Year 11 and a Spring Mock in Year 11
