#### How will the course be structured?

##### RO21 – Exam Unit

##### Essential values of care for use with individuals in care settings

- Understand how to support individuals to maintain their rights
- Understand the importance of the values of care and how they are applied
- Understand how legislation impacts on care settings
- Understand how personal hygiene, safety and security measures protect individuals

##### Communicating and working with individuals in health, social care and early settings

- Understand how to communicate effectively
- Understand the personal qualities that contribute to effective care
- Be able to communicate effectively within a health, social care and early years setting

An additional 2 units will be selected by staff to complete the award

#### How will I be assessed?

##### RO21

Unit RO21 is an examined unit where you will sit a one-hour examination paper which is set and marked by OCR

##### RO22 through to RO31

Units RO22 through to RO31 are assessed through a series of tasks for model assignments, students will be issued assignments. The assignments are set by OCR, marked internally then moderated by OCR
