### What will I be studying?

Through a series of extended case studies, students will explore ethical, philosophical and religious responses to the following

- 1. Conflict and Justice
- 2. Medical Ethics (Abortion)
- 3. How Belief Affects Relationships
- 4. Issues of Equality
- 5. Suffering and Evil

## What skills will I develop?

- An enquiring approach to the study of religion and human experience
- An understanding of how to put key concepts into religious and secular contexts
- An ability to communicate, reflect on and develop values, opinions and attitudes
- The ability to apply beliefs and values to real life situations

#### How will the course be structured?

The course will be delivered within a carousel system, alongside IT and CCW

### Year 11
