### CYCLING TO SCHOOL

All students must travel to and from school in a safe and acceptable manner.

- All students must ride sensibly and follow the Highway Code
- Students are expected to maintain their bicycles in good working order
- A bicycle helmet (which meets current Safety Regulations) should be worn when cycling
- Bicycle lights must be used when visibility is poor
- The security of bicycles is the responsibility of the individual and measures should be taken to protect against theft
- Students are expected to lock their bicycles in the storage facility on Dryden Avenue playground
- Students must dismount before entering school premises and push their bicycles to the entrance gates by the girls' toilets
- Students must not ride their bikes anywhere on the school site. This includes the car park

#### Cycling Code of Conduct

- I will wear a helmet (which meets current Safety Regulations) when riding to and from school
- I will use bike lights and wear appropriate clothing when visibility is poor, when riding to and from school
- I will plan my route to and from school carefully with an adult and make sure I always use this route
- I will get off and walk with my bike if the traffic is too busy
- I will keep my bike in good condition. Every time I use my bike I will check that the brakes work and my reflectors are clean
- I will carry anything I need in a back pack, and I will never carry anything under my arm or hanging from the handlebars
- I will not listen to any musical device when I am riding my bike
- I will get off and walk with my bike before I get to the school gates
- I will use a lock to secure my bike in the Dryden Avenue playground facility

I understand that if I do not follow the code of conduct, I may be sanctioned and I will not be able to ride my bike to and from school.
