Studying Food Preparation and Nutrition helps to develop the following skills: Planning, practical skills, analysis, evaluation, research and independence. It can lead to 6th Form courses such as A Level Food Studies and BTEC qualifications in catering or hospitality. It can also lead to apprenticeships in industries such as catering or food science/nutrition. Current employment opportunities where a qualification in Food would be advantageous include catering, event Management, teaching, hospitality, nutrition and health, food science and in the military services.
