



## 13.2 Governors Attendance update

Attendance focus across half term 1:

- Tiered letters have been sent for all students of concern for attendance, school punctuality and punctuality to lessons
- Provision for maintaining high standards of attendance has been mapped to ensure consistency in approach
- *Attendance and punctuality matters impact on education* posters developed and shared in assemblies and tutor time. The tutorial Challenge 96 programme has been relaunched to create interhouse/tutor competition with high attendance
- 27 cases of unapproved holiday reported to Ealing Council and fixed penalty notices issued
- Attendance contracts, EHAPs, reports to EWO and IHCPs opened to support families with attendance concerns
- Working in partnership with the DoF to examine DMHS being an Attendance Hub for 23/24
