What will I be studying?

- What the environment in which hospitality and catering providers operate is like
- Hospitality and catering provisions and operations
- How hospitality and catering provision meets health and safety requirements
- How food can cause ill health
- How to propose a hospitality and catering provision to meet specific requirements
- The importance of nutrition when planning menus
- Menu planning
- Various practical techniques and technical skills used within the catering profession to cook a range of dishes

What skills will I develop?

- Computing skills
- Working with others and communication skills
- Problem solving
- Practical and technical skills
- Designing and making skills
- Working within environmental, social and economic challenges
- Developing prototypes
- General practical skills
- Knife skills such as filleting
- Preparing fruits and vegetables
- Use of a cooker and other kitchen appliances
- Various cooking methods
- Health and safety within a kitchen environment

How will the course be structured?

- **3 lessons per week**
2 lesson focussing on topics to be covered. 1 lesson practical
- The course is comprised of 2 assessments.
Unit 1 - The Hospitality and Catering Industry - On screen, e-assessment. Short and extended answer questions based around applied situations.
Unit 2 - Hospitality and Catering in Action - Learners apply their learning to safely prepare, cook and present nutritional dishes.

How will I be assessed?
