


Session 1: Knowledge organiser checks and ready to learn expectations

Session 1: UNIFORM CHECK




- Blazer
- White shirt
- Top button fastened
- School tie: covers top button and length reaches the waist
- Knee-length navy skirt / full length navy, tailored trousers
- Leather, black shoes
- Tights / navy socks
- Plain coat
- Summer: remove jumper and hold blazer



- No more than 1 pair of small studs or sleepers, in your earlobes.
- No bracelets, rings, necklaces (except if religious and worn under uniform)
- No coats with logos / patterns/ reflective strips / fur
- No boots, trainers, heels
- Sleeves must be rolled down
- No makeup or unnatural hair colour
- No extreme hair styles


WINDING TUTOR GROUDS GET TO GEOEBRATE

Session 1: Book Pride

Keeping your exercise books neat, organised and tidy will ensure you are ready to learn and prepared.

Students have the remaining tutor time to follow the instructions below, and to ensure their exercise books are impeccable – showing excellent character:

- 1. Ensure all books have treasury tags in place (FYI, to support students in inserting treasury tags correctly, <u>this video</u> from 0.47 onwards provides a worked example!). There should be no loose work.
- 2. PLCS are tagged in properly and in use.
- 3. Plastic book covers are in use
- 4. Titles, classwork and the date are underlined for each lesson neatly.
- 5. Target Tracking sheets are filled in (KS4 only) and clearly visible.
- 6. Ensure any assessments are easy to find in your exercise book alongside feedback received.
