	8. <i>Who were Henry VIII's wives and what were the reasons for the marriages?</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Good if you can state who Henry's wives were. Great if you can explain the reasons why he wanted to marry each wife. Excellent if you can evaluate the reasons behind his actions to each wife. 			
	9. <i>Was king Henry VIII's reign a military success?</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Good to tell the story of the main military events of Henry VIII's reign. Great to complete a report assessing the military successes and failures of Henry VIII's reign. Outstanding to choose which interpretation of Henry VIII's reign seems more appropriate using your own knowledge.
